

Using ROS Bag

ROS bag is a nice tool for recording any data that you need to be able to play back at a later time.

Recording

The normal usage is:

```
rosvbag record <TOPIC1> ... <TOPIC(N)>
```

If you want to output to a file with a timestamp and specific prefix:

```
rosvbag record -o <PREFIX> <TOPIC1> ... <TOPIC(N)>
```

In general we use this format for recording bag files:

```
rosvbag record -a -o <PREFIX>
```

Playback

The normal usage is:

```
rosvbag play <BAG_FILE1> ... <BAG_FILE(N)>
```

To play back a specific topic from the bag file:

```
rosvbag play --topics <TOPIC1> ... <TOPIC(N)> <BAG_FILE1> ... <BAG_FILE(N)>
```

Info

To see information about a bag file, rosvbag info can help.

```
rosvbag info <BAG_FILE1> ... <BAG_FILE(N)>
```
